General Purpose:

To provide for and ensure a reasonably safe skiing environment for our guests and fellow employees.

Essential Functions:

- To provide medical assistance and transport, skier safety, search and rescue support, trail maintenance efforts, lift evacuation if necessary, duty station and dispatch responsibilities, equipment maintenance, and other assigned duties
- High level decision-making skills

Basic Requirements:

- American Heart Association First Aid/CPR/AED, Wilderness First Responder, or similar Outdoor Emergency Care training
- Ability to lift and carry toboggans weighing as much as 70 lbs
- Other tasks include skiing in difficult conditions, working in cold and often inclement conditions, high elevations, carrying and transporting unwieldy materials such as tower pads, medical equipment, etc
- No physical limitations which could prevent you from carrying out the duties expected of a capable patroller
- Clear communication skills to hear and speak clearly on radio calls, respond to skiers needing assistance, and for other communication using radios and telephones
- All Ski Patrol staff are responsible for keeping aid rooms and patrol dispatch areas clean and organized
- High level of responsibility, commitment, and professionalism
- Reliable winter transportation



Preferred Experience & Skills:

- Previous ski patrolling experience, mountaineering, search & rescue, and/or experience within the medical field preferred
- Mountaineering skills with technical rope experience helpful
- Industry experience, i.e. ski instructor, lift operator, trail crew preferred, but not required
- Knowledge of White Pine Ski Area valuable but not required.
