The goal is to create a clean and orderly environment for guests which is a critical factor in maintaining and strengthening reputation. **Areas of responsibility include lodge common areas and lodge bathrooms, with the inclusion of the White Pine cabins and campground.**

The Details:

- Maintain clean and orderly common areas (interior as well as exterior) whether located at the base area lodge, the campground, or the cabins.

- Ability to work with little supervision and maintain a high level of efficient performance.
- Customer-oriented and friendly.
- Prioritization and time management skills a must.
- Work quickly and efficiently without compromising quality.
- Work well unsupervised.
- Be able to lift up to 40 pounds.
- Ability to walk up and down several flights of stairs while working.
- Ability to maintain a professional appearance and interact positively with guests.
