Wage & Status: Full-Time, seasonal (approximately November through March) with potential to be year-round. Wage depends on experience.

Role & Responsibilities:

The Maintenance employee must perform the essential duties and responsibilities efficiently and accurately, and without causing a significant safety threat to self or others.

- Perform minor repairs and maintenance procedures on facility equipment and appliances as necessary
- Shovel snow from walkways and sprinkle ice melt to keep people from slipping and falling
- Cut tree limbs, and remove fallen trees, that pose a danger
- Carry out other various maintenance procedures as assigned or requested by the Maintenance Manager and/or General Manager
- Rely on instructions and guidelines to perform the functions of the job
- Rely on experience and judgment to plan and accomplish goals
- A certain degree of creativity and latitude is sometimes necessary
- Assist in problem resolution to minimize equipment downtime
- Look for opportunities to continually improve maintenance processes
- Work with all company personnel in a cooperative and professional manner
- Strictly adhere to all safety rules, policies and procedures required by White Pine Resort, law, and/or what is recognized as common practice in the industry
- Ensure work is performed safely and efficiently
- Follow written and verbal instructions and perform other tasks as directed by management
- Ability to operate equipment such as a snowmobile, 4-wheeler, etc. in a safe manner

Requirements and Qualifications:

- Reliable winter transportation is required.
- Flexible schedule, including weekends and holidays.
- Must pass a pre-employment background check.
- Have and maintain a valid driver's license with a clean driving record.
- Demonstrate adequate mechanical aptitude.
- Proficient in the proper use of, and care of, various power and hand tools (i.e., chainsaws, drills, saws, etc.).
- Good verbal and written communication skills in English.
- Ability to comprehend and follow direction, perform basic math, good time management and team member skills.



- Must be a team player with enthusiasm, initiative, and pride in work well done; self-starter dedicated to continual quality improvement.
- Typical Physical Activities - Standing, sitting, walking, bending, stooping, reaching, twisting, kneeling, working in confined areas, reaching overhead, driving, and operating heavy equipment, grasping, pushing, pulling, lifting, and carrying up to 50lbs.
- Typical Environmental Conditions - Inside and outside areas of a typical ski and summer resort facility, which includes working with and around large machinery, variations in temperature, noise, odors, humidity, lint, and dust, in general offices or on outside grounds.
- Heavy equipment operation experience preferred.
- Basic carpentry experience preferred.
- A high level of responsibility and reliability are required.
