Wage & Status: This is for a part-time, seasonal, position (approximately November through March). Wage depends on experience.

Role & Responsibilities:

This position assists the White Pine kitchen staff by taking orders, handling cash/credit card transactions, meal container preparations, adhering to the restaurant menu, and following food health and safety procedures.

- Setting up, cleaning, and organizing workstations
- Preparing ingredients for the shift if necessary; i.e., washing vegetables, chopping, etc.
- Taking orders and following direction from the Head Cook
- Maintaining a clean work environment according to food health and safety standards
- Handling multiple food orders at one time
- Monitoring multiple food orders as new orders are received to maintain efficient order fulfillment pace
- Ensuring each guest order has the correct food and sides
- Delivering food orders in a timely manner
- Storing all food properly
- Sanitizing and cleaning workstations
- Monitoring supply inventory and notifying Head Cook of items which may need to be reordered/restocked
- Advises Head Cook of any anticipated problems
- Suggestive up-selling to customers, adding items such as fries with a burger, etc.

Requirements and Qualifications:

- Reliable winter transportation is required
- Flexible schedule, including weekends and holidays
- Must pass pre-employment background check
- Able to read and communicate effectively in English
- Able to work in a fast-paced environment (and sometimes very slow environment)
- Able to multitask, prioritize, and manage time efficiently
- Physical endurance to stand for long periods of time
- Self-motivated
- Work well as part of a team and on individual tasks



- Able to quickly memorize complex or multiple orders
- Previous relevant work experience a plus
- Able to work early mornings and weekends
- Able to bend, move, and lift up to 25 pounds or more
- Physically able to stand, bend, kneel, and move for long periods of time
